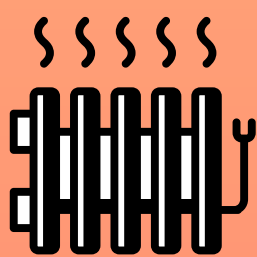
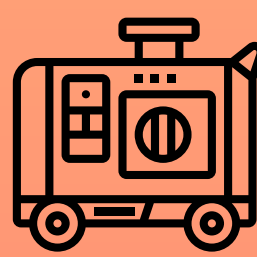


OCTOBER FIRE PREVENTION MONTH SAFETY TIPS

Plug only one heat-producing appliance into an electrical outlet at a time.



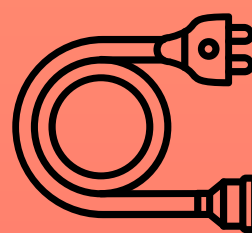
Keep portable generators outside and far away from your home.



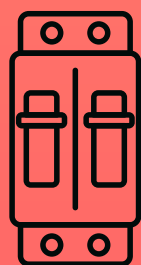
Check cords regularly for damage. Do not use appliances with a damaged cord.



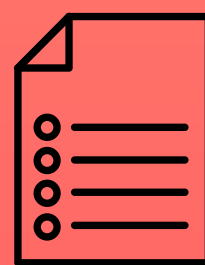
Only use extension cords temporarily. Have an electrician install outlets where needed.



Stay current with NEC[®] requirements such as Arc Fault Circuit Interrupters (AFCIs)



Follow manufacturer's instructions on where and how to use appliances properly.



Remember

AFCIs are designed to detect dangerous arcing behind walls and elsewhere **to stop an electrical fire before it can start.**
